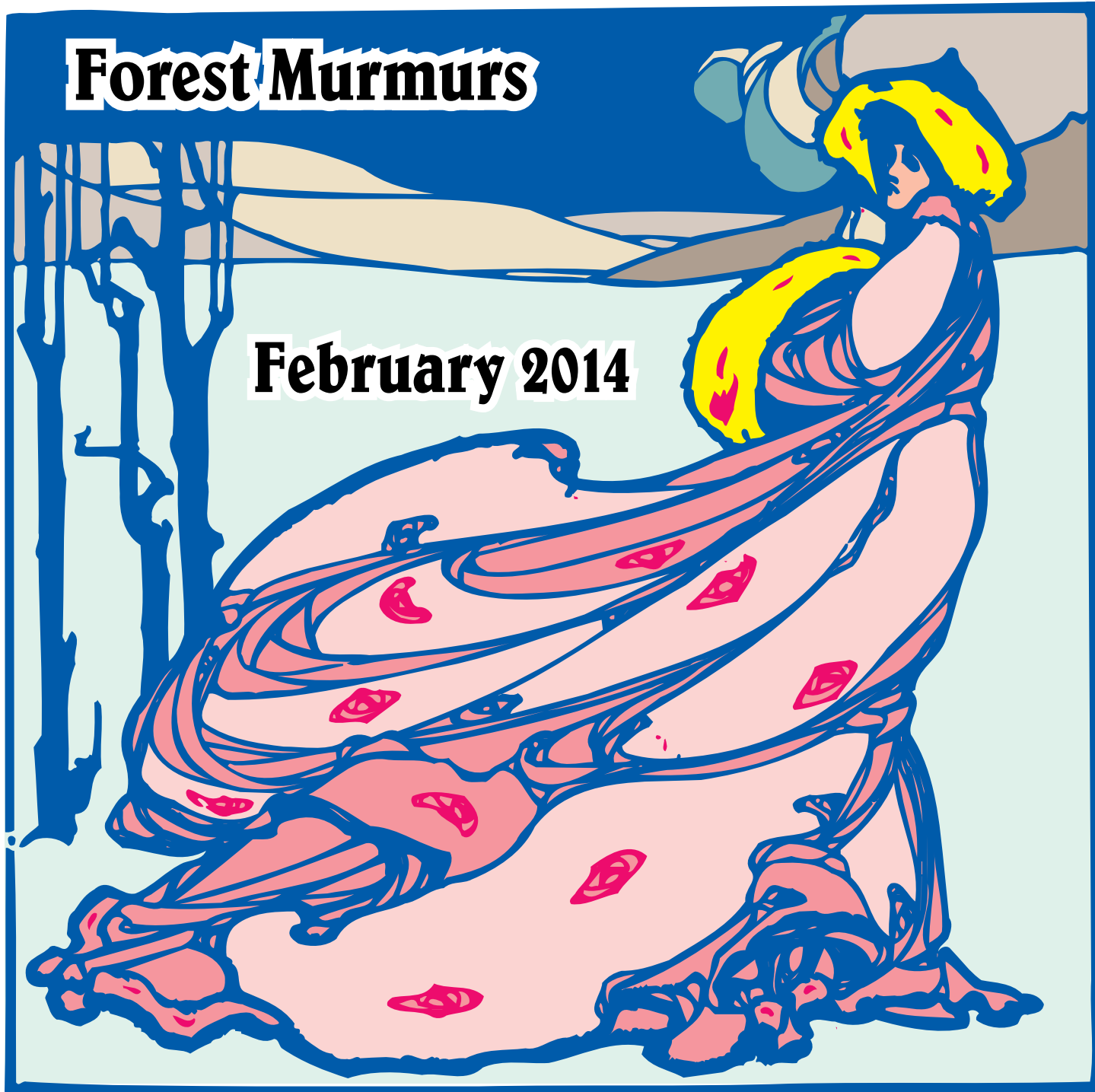

Board of Trustees Regular Meeting
November 18, 2013**

Trustees Present: Sue Hanley, Roberta Havholm, Greg Herman, Collin Monger, Jennifer Kelley, Chuck Evanhoe, and Jake Bontatibus

Trustees Absent: Bob Gray and Shelton Monger

Sue Hanley called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m.

Police Report: Officer Kennard was present from the Dayton Police Department to discuss the monthly crime statistics for the Forest Ridge Area. There were only a few incidents over the past month including a theft from motor vehicle, and a vandalism. He also discussed a recent effort to catch speeders in Forest Ridge resulted in 20 tickets. Officers Campolongo and Beane from the Dayton Police Department were also present to represent the Community Problem Response Team. They said that they are the team to call to report a drug house or similar major issues.

Dayton east district is trying to implement a program called Court Watch. Residents interested in participating should contact Hillary Elner at hilary45410@gmail.com.

Sgt. Colon was present from the Riverside Police Department to report on the area crime activity. He said there very few crimes and no property crimes in the past month. He also reminded residents to not leave property or cash visible in your vehicles and lock your vehicles.

Visitors: No visitors were present.

Northeast Priority Board: The Northeast priority board donated \$1,000 to buy school supplies for two local schools in lieu of having a neighborhood festival.

Minutes: Collin Monger moved that the October 21, 2013 meeting minutes be accepted with corrections. Jake Bontatibus seconded.

Vote 6-0

Treasurer: Dan Freeman, Treasurer, gave his report. The General Fund balance is \$40,253.16. Replacement reserve balance is \$67,759.06. We received 1 full and 1 partial assessments (\$269.00) in October, and we've received 1 full and 1 partial (\$297.50) so far this month; so there are 54 full and 2 partial assessments still open (\$11,964.00). This compares to 69 assessments (\$14,835.00) still open at the same time in 2012.

Roberta Havholm moved that the report be accepted. Colin Monger seconded.

Vote 6-0

Murmurs: Roberta Havholm discussed the December issue. The pertinent articles will be the Luminarias, Baked Goods Article, Swim Team Wrap Up, and Outstanding Assessments. Deadline

for article submission is November 29th, 2013. It will be delivered the second weekend of December. She also said the new printing company for the Murmurs is Progressive Printers and will be done by the same workers as did it at the previous printer. She is comfortable working with them and all costs will be the same.

Communications Committee Report: Nothing to report.

Website: Greg Herman discussed the website and the board talked about what needs to be updated on the website.

Pool: No report.

Pool and Outdoor Recreation Committee: Shelton Monger was not present but Sue Hanley reported that the pool has been winterized and chairs will be ordered soon. Mr. Monger does not yet have a quote to remediate the spalling problem in the L-shaped pool but will follow up as able.

Green Areas: Mitch Bird, the Green Area Supervisor, was present and submitted the Green Area report.

Current Projects: Mowing, Fall clean-up, Cut down flowers and clean out beds, applied late fall feeding, Tree care and trimming,

To Do: Downed trees at Silver Arrow and Meadowsweet, Willow Branch, Mow Chuck area, hiking trails, Winterize spraying equipment, Clean out gutters on both buildings, Tree work from insect or storm damage, PM on all equipment going into storage, Applied 6000 pounds of late fall fertilizer.

Mr. Bird said that a replacement heavy duty commercial mower will cost \$9,495.00 plus tax for a Scag Turf Tiger. He also said that fence posts and rails will cost \$948.69.

Asset Management Committee: No report.

Old Business: Greg Herman moved that the 2014 budget be accepted as submitted pending the CPI report to be released on November 20, 2013. Collin Monger seconded.

Vote 7-0

Sue Hanley said that the Halloween parade went well.

New Business: Sue Hanley said that she is looking for baked good donations for December 24th, 2013 (between 9am and 4pm) for first responders.

Adjournment: Chuck Evanhoe moved the meeting be adjourned and Greg Herman seconded.

Sue Hanley called the meeting to order at 7:35 p.m.

Police Report: Officers Dilley, Campolongo, Cartee, and Gross were present from the Dayton Police Department to discuss the monthly crime statistics for the Forest Ridge Area. The incidents consisted of 1 burglary, 2 shoplifting, 4 theft from building, 1 menacing, and 1 vandalism to a property.

Officer Dilley discussed Court Watch and stressed the importance of the grass-roots program. He also asked about any long-term issues that may exist. Sue Hanley discussed a property with broken windows and other issues. Officer Dilley suggested contacting the housing authority directly.

Visitors: No visitors were present.

Northeast Priority Board: Nothing to report.

Minutes: Roberta Havholm moved that the November 18, 2013 meeting minutes be accepted with corrections. Greg Herman seconded.

Vote 6-0

Treasurer: Dan Freeman, Treasurer, gave his report. The General Fund balance is \$33,472.50. Replacement reserve balance is \$67,762.67. We received 1 full and 1 partial assessments (\$328.50) in November, and we've received none (\$0.00) so far this month; so there are 54 full and 2 partial assessments still open (\$11,964.00). This compares to 65 assessments (\$14,140.00) still open at the same time in 2012.

Shelton Monger moved that the report be accepted. Roberta Havholm seconded.

Vote 6-0

Murmurs: Roberta Havholm said that there is no January issue, and that the December issue was late due to printing issues.

Communications Committee Report: Nothing to report.

Website: Greg Herman discussed the website and said the Forest Ridge residents can now sign up to receive emails when updates are posted.

Pool: Ellie Monger said she ordered chairs totaling \$1,100.

Pool and Outdoor Recreation Committee: Greg Herman reported that the swim team has hired a new coach, Matt Normile.

Jesse Morgan said he is going to prepare some updates for the website about the soccer program. He also discussed some advertising opportunities in the surrounding associations.

Green Areas: Mitch Bird, the Green Area Supervisor, was present and submitted the Green Area report.

Mowing is complete; all equipment will be serviced and ready for the next season. Leaf clean-up limited by early snow, mostly complete. Spray equipment has been flushed and drained. Cleaned-up storm damaged trees (a few left to clean up).

Sue Hanley asked that Mitch purchase additional reflectors and fence equipment before the end of the year. The board also discussed Mr. Bird's management contract. Mr. Bird is to get back with comments soon.

Asset Management Committee: No report.

Old Business: Greg Herman reported that the Luminarias distribution went well.

Sue Hanley discussed the "baked goods for first responders" planning is going well and still planned for December 24th, 2013 (between 9am and 4pm).

The next semi-annual meeting is scheduled for March 3, 2013 at 7:30pm at Forest Ridge Baptist Church. The board is working on whom to invite, including Hillary Elner from Court Watch of Dayton.

New Business: Sue Hanley said that she is going to send an appreciation letter to Mr. Sweet for clean-up work he did. She also discussed the possibility of a new Girl Scout troop, and she is working with a coordinator to help her gauge interest.

Adjournment: Roberta Havholm moved the meeting be adjourned and Greg Herman seconded.
