Board of Trustees Regular Meeting
March 3, 2014**

Trustees Present: Bob Gray, Roberta Havholm, Greg Herman, Jennifer Kelley, Shelton Monger, Chuck Evanhoe, Jake Bontatibus, and Collin Monger

Trustees Absent: Sue Hanley

Bob Gray called the meeting to order at 6:38 p.m.

Police Report: No police were present.

Visitors: No visitors were present.

Northeast Priority Board: Nothing to report.

Minutes: Shelton Monger moved that the January 20, 2014 meeting minutes be accepted with corrections. Chuck Evanhoe seconded.

Vote 8-0

Treasurer: Dan Freeman, Treasurer, gave his report. The General Fund balance is \$56,122.03. Replacement reserve balance is \$91,262.15. We received 287 full and 2 partial assessments (\$63,920.00) in January, and we've received 203 full and 1 partial (\$44,920.00) so far this month; so there are 631 full and 2 partial assessments still open (\$139,671.00). This compares to 631 assessments (\$138,377.00) still open at the same time in 2013.

Chuck Evanhoe moved that the report be accepted. Shelton Monger seconded.

Vote 8-0

Murmurs: No Report

Communications Committee Report: Bob Gray reported that 8 welcome packets were delivered, and he has several remaining to deliver.

Website: Greg Herman discussed the website updates including the ability to pay 2014 dues.

Pool: Ellie Monger, the pool manager, reported that new chairs have been delivered.

Pool and Outdoor Recreation Committee: Shelton Monger discussed a some necessary pool repairs for 2014. The estimate for a major tile repair is \$3,500. Jake Bontatibus moved that up to \$4,000 be approved to cover contingencies, to spend on this capital repair. Collin Monger seconded.

Vote 8-0

Jake Bontatibus suggested a change in the pool rules to allow alcohol at private pool parties. He made a motion to allow beer at private pool parties (personally brought in by attendees – plastic/cans only). Collin Monger seconded.

Vote 1-7

Jesse Morgan reported that Spring soccer will be starting soon. He will be contacting coaches this week.

Green Areas:

Mitch Bird, green area supervisor reported:

Wrapping up equipment repairs and scheduled work on equipment in March. Attended four hours of ODA spraying recertification classes. Before mowing, we will clean up flowers beds and mulch the few that we missed last year. Many Ash trees will be removed this year.

Asset Management Committee: Bob Gray reported they have toured the area looking for drainage culverts that need to be replaced. They have also advertised for summer positions with Green Area Maintenance.

Old Business: The next semi-annual meeting is scheduled for March 3, 2013 at 7:30pm at Forest Ridge Baptist Church. The Riverside City Manager, Court Watch and the Montgomery County Prosecutor are planning to attend.

New Business: The 2014 Garage Sale is tentatively scheduled for May 17th.

Mr. Monger asked about Ty Tyson's recommendations regarding the debris in Running Creek Reserve. The board will inspect the area when the weather clears in the Spring.

Adjournment: Chuck Evanhoe moved the meeting be adjourned and Greg Herman seconded.

There are 8 dual meets from June 17 – July 17. Meets are on most Tuesdays and Thursdays.

Championships: Saturday, July 26 **Awards picnic:** Sunday, July 27

Cost: FRA – \$60 registration fee per swimmer (family max. \$150) – includes a t-shirt and swim cap

Non-resident of Forest Ridge Association - \$70 fee per swimmer (family max \$180)* - includes a t-shirt and swim cap

* This fee does not include membership to the FRA pool or use of the pool other than for swim team practice, meets and special events.

Children ages 5-18 (as of June 1, 2014), who can swim the length of the lap pool, are eligible to join the team. If you aren't sure your swimmer can swim the length of the pool they can come to the first week of practice on a trial basis.

From The OHIO BMV Motor Scooter Information

REMINDER OF OHIO'S MOTOR SCOOTER LAWS

Motor scooters and mini-motorcycles have become hot items among children and teenagers.

Parents, grandparents and other family members are spending their hard earned money to purchase scooters and mini-motorcycles – just to find out that most cannot be operated on Ohio's roads and their children - or grandchildren cannot legally operate the vehicle.

In Ohio, the motor scooters and mini-motorcycles cannot be legally operated on Ohio's roadways unless - they are titled, registered, covered by the proper insurance and the operator is at least 16 years old with a motorcycle license or endorsement on his or her driver license.

Most of the small electric and gas powered motor scooters, which are sold in sporting good stores and department stores, are not roadworthy, therefore cannot be titled or registered.

In order for the scooter or the mini-motorcycle to be considered roadworthy each must contain a seat, not more than three wheels in contact with the ground, contain the proper brake lights, turn signals, horn, rearview mirrors and headlights.

The county title office will then issue a title for your motor scooter or mini-motorcycle. The title will cost \$5.

After you purchase your title, you will need to register your vehicle. The annual registration costs \$28.50, plus a permissive tax if required and any new plate fees.

The motor scooter and mini-motorcycle will be issued a motorcycle plate, which will need to be attached to the vehicle.

Please make sure you have the proper insurance coverage on your motor scooter or mini-motorcycle, before registering your vehicle. The owner and the operator of the motor scooter or mini-motorcycle are subject to financial responsibility suspensions if the proper insurance is not maintained.

And finally, in order for the individual to legally operate the motor scooter or mini-motorcycle – he or she must be at least 16 years old and hold a valid driver license with a motorcycle endorsement or a motorcycle license. It is very important to know Ohio's road laws and signs before an individual attempts to operate a vehicle of any kind on Ohio's roadways. Licensed drivers have been tested on their knowledge and skills.

Please, know the law before you purchase a motor scooter or a mini-motorcycle. Know where they may be operated and who can operate them. If you have questions you may contact the BMV at 614-752-7800 and you also need to check with your local jurisdiction before you make the purchase.

It's about your safety, your children's safety and other drivers' safety.

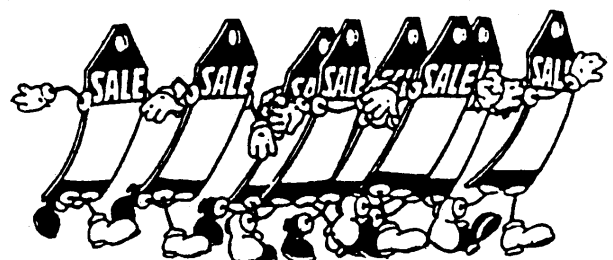

Excerpts of the Parking Ordinance from the City of Dayton

For the purpose of this section, "residential zone" shall mean those districts classified and regulated as R-1 through R-8 Residential Districts by §§ 150.100 through 150.149.

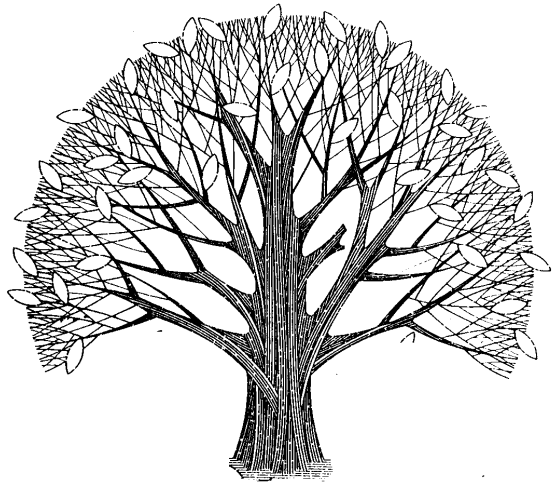
(B)

No person shall park or permit any motor vehicle having motor power designed and used for carrying merchandise or freight to remain parked on any street in a residential zone in the city between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m.

(D)

No person shall park or permit to remain parked, a trailer, semi-trailer, travel trailer, house trailer, recreational vehicle, camper, truck camper, boat, a boat trailer, or mobile home on any street in a residential zone in the city except when continuously and actively engaged in loading or unloading goods from such equipment or vehicle, but in no event longer than permitted by any regulation in force at the site.

Call for Lifeguard Applications 2014 Season

The Forest Ridge Association is accepting applications for lifeguards and Recreation Supervisors for the 2014 season. Those interested must have current Lifeguard training, Standard First Aid, and CPR for the Professional Rescuer. Those with old Lifeguard Training will be required to update when the pool opens. WSI certification is recommended for consideration but not required for the available positions. Applications should be in résumé form and must include copies of the front and back of all certifications. The résumé should include any experience with young children, school, and community activities. Also include 2 written references from former employers, teachers, or community leaders. Previous employees of FRA do not need to submit references. The staff is responsible for helping with the opening of the pool and must be available to work on weekends during May (possible exceptions if away at school). You must also include your swimsuit and shirt size, date you can start full-time, all dates you must have off, and when you return to school.

Each year of experience means one season consisting of at least eight full weeks. For example, if an individual was hired prior to June 30 and works through Labor Day, the individual will be paid the next step the next year. If the individual is hired after July 1, the individual will be paid the same step for the entire next year. Prior experience at another pool, regardless of the number of years, will qualify the individual for a Step 2 if it can be verified that the individual has at least one full year of experience.



Residents of Forest Ridge receive preference for these positions, assuming they are otherwise qualified. WSI qualified applicants are preferred.

¹ Lifeguard certifications must be current at all times. It is the responsibility of each employee to provide such certification to the Recreation Area Manager. The base rate will be effective from the date the manager receives the certification, not retroactive to the date of the certification. If the Manager does not have a current lifeguard certification on file, the employee will be paid \$3.95/hour until such certification is provided.

² Current WSI certificates must be provided to the Recreation Area Manager in order to receive this rate. Once the WSI certification expires, the individual will be paid at the base rate until a current WSI certificate is again provided to the Recreation Area Manager. The WSI rate is effective on the date the Recreation Area Manager receives the current certificate, not retroactive to the effective date of the certificate.

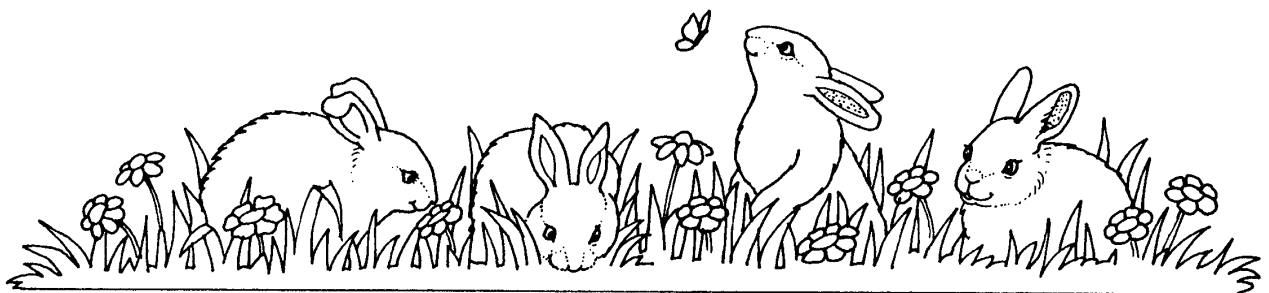
Spring Critter Information

Spring is right around the corner! You may notice more animals in your yards as the weather warms up. Here are a few tips on how to prep your house to keep the critters out.

- Block open spaces under porches and sheds with heavy duty mesh.
- Cap chimneys and close openings into attics.
- Do not leave cat or dog food outside over night.

Many animals will be having offspring in early spring. Remember, their best chance for survival is to stay with their mother. If you find a baby animal return it to its nest. Your scent will not scare the mother away. Keep pets and children away from the area and give the mother until the next morning to return.
