Forest Ridge Association Board of Trustees Regular Meeting October 20, 2014

Trustees Present: Bob Gray, Sue Hanley, Jake Bontatibus, Roberta Havholm, Shelton Monger, Chuck Evanhoe, and Greg Herman

Trustees Absent: Jennifer Kelley

Bob Gray called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m.

Police Report:: Officers Reeb and Cartee were present to discuss the criminal activity for the past month. There was one theft from motor vehicle, one vandalism, one assault, and one impersonation. Bob Gray asked about traffic enforcement. Officer Cartee said he has not been out for traffic enforcement due to other calls.

No officers present from the City of Riverside Police Department.

Northeast Priority Board: No report.

Minutes: Roberta Havholm moved that the September 15, 2014 meeting minutes be accepted with corrections. Shelton Monger seconded.

Treasurer: Dan Freeman, Treasurer, reported that the General Fund balance is \$40,020.40. Replacement reserve balance is \$91,289.48. We received 3 full and 3 partial assessments (\$594.50) in September, and we've received 2 partials (\$100.00) so far this month; so there are 54 full and 7 partial assessments still open (\$12,195.92). This compares to 59 assessments (\$12,621.00) still open at the same time in 2013.

Murmurs: Roberta Havholm was present and submitted her report for the November issue. The theme will be Halloween Parade Results. The pertinent articles will include Halloween Parade Results and Stebbins Con. It will be delivered the first weekend of November. It will be printed on White paper with a full color cover. The article deadline is October 24, 2014.

Communications Committee Report: Bob Gray reported that he has four welcome packets to deliver.

Website: Greg Herman said he has improved some of the navigation on the website.

Our Facebook page now has 856 likes as compared to 852 last month.

Greg also discussed the nextdoor.com site and encouraged residents to sign up.

Pool: Ellie Monger was present and said the pools are winterized. She said she has some work to do to finish up the office, but the pool is ready to be closed for the winter.

Pool and Outdoor Recreation Committee: Shelton Monger reported that he has begun working on the deck around the pool.

Sue Hanley reported for Jesse Morgan that the soccer season has gone well and plans to purchase paint and equipment with remaining funds. He also discussed the soccer picnic that will be held after the games on Saturday October 31.

Green Areas: Chris Tooley, green area supervisor, submitted a report on the following Green Area activity in the previous month:

- Cut down three more trees
- Removed graffiti
- Edging sidewalks
- Cleaned up gazebo
- Tree trimming
- Mowing

Asset Management Committee: Roberta Havholm said that they are waiting for the weather to cooperate in order to start construction on the culverts.

Old Business: Bob Gray said that the gazebo work on the lower portion is complete. Jake is getting two estimates for repairing the gazebo roof.

Jake gave an update on the Halloween parade. He said he has most of the decorations and candy for the parade. He will be getting more candy and prizes. He has several more things to finish up before Saturday. Greg will put the registration form on the website and Facebook.

Terry Chandler discussed a poll that he did of forty Forest Ridge Association homes.

Roberta Havholm moved to table the discussion. Sue Hanley seconded.

New business: The board will fill the vacant board position as soon as possible. They will post the open position in the Murmurs and online and take time to evaluate candidates.

The board discussed the tree trimming notification that came out for residents of Riverside. The board decided to post information that will encourage residents to contact the City regarding the amount of notice they received for compliance.

The By-laws for the Forest Ridge Association do not authorize us to require home owners to mow or weed their lawns.

If you are not able to deliver the treats, please email the above address and we will make arrangements to pick up from your home.


