Forest Ridge Association Board of Trustees Regular Meeting August 17, 2015

Trustees Present: Sue Hanley, Jennifer Kelley, Maria Ford, Roberta Havholm, Shelton Monger, Greg Herman, Chuck Evanhoe, and Duane Veley

Trustees Absent: Jesse Morgan – Left after his updates

Jennifer Kelley called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m.

Jesse Morgan discussed information he received about a potential Frisbee golf course throughout the Ridge. Due to the nature of how Frisbee golf is handled it would require Forest Ridge to be listed online as a Frisbee golf course. The Disk Golf Association cannot donate funds on courses that are not listed for general public use. The DGA discussed that the green areas were not ideal sizes for the Frisbee golf. Typically they look for wider areas. If Forest Ridge has more interest it could look into using donated or used baskets for the course. The baskets are usually in the \$3-4 thousand range for an entire course.

Jesse Morgan also gave a quick update on soccer season. Two more coaches are needed. There are 50+ kids signed up and more to come. The season is looking really good and Forest Ridge has almost 30 kids in the middle bracket.

Police Report: Officer Williams was present from the Dayton Police Department and reported that there were only seven crimes over the last thirty days. Crimes involved property, shoplifting, theft from car, vandalism and two drugs violations in Kroger on Brandt Pike.

No officers present from the City of Riverside Police Department.

Visitors: Terry Chandler

Northeast Priority Board: No report.

Minutes: Chuck Evanhoe moved that the July 20, 2015 meeting minutes be accepted with corrections. Sue Hanley seconded.

Treasurer: Sue Hanley asked if we can receive a list of the assessments that were paid from the list that was published in the Murmurs. Chuck Evanhoe moved that the August 17, 2015 Treasurers report be accepted and Maria Ford seconded.

Vote 8-0

Murmurs: Roberta Havholm was present and submitted her report for the September issue. The theme is the Halloween parade. The murmurs will contain information regarding the election of trustees and soccer information for the fall season. Last day to submit an article will be August 21, 2015. It will be delivered a week early due to the semi-annual meeting.

Communications Committee Report: Jennifer Kelley reported that three welcome packets were delivered.

Website: Greg Herman reported we have 387 neighbors signed up for the Nextdoor app and we have 980 likes on the Forest Ridge Facebook page.

Pool: Ellie Monger was present and reported that August pool participation was good and they have had lots of pool parties this year. She also mentioned that they were having problems with the pool lawn mower and Chris Tooley will be mowing around the pool for them until they are able to get it fixed. The pool held a family raft night and it went

very well. The concession stand has done well this year with candy sells. Pool hours will stay the same until August 31, 2015 and will change to 4pm-8pm. Labor Day weekend hours will be the usual times. September 8, 2015 will be the doggie swim.

Pool and Outdoor Recreation Committee: Shelton Monger said that he is working with the contractor that laid the floor and fixed the spalling in pool area to give us a quote on the tiles that need to be replaced. They are looking to have this done in the fall. Shelton Monger is also looking into a new P.A. system for swim meets and also for music played during the swim season. He will have more information to follow.

Green Areas: Chris Tooley, green area supervisor, submitted a report on the following Green Area activity in the previous month:

*To Do: Stripe soccer fields, Light bulbs at sign, Dead tree at little park culvert, Fence/gate hinges at pool

*Purchased: Oil/misc. equipment parts, Cement for Lawson fence, Soccer paint, Rented post hole digger

*Recommendations: Lawn aerator, Lawn roller

Asset Management Committee: No new updates. Green Areas are in good shape.

Old Business:

Trustees running for new term: Roberta Havholm-No. Greg Herman and Shelton Monger – Yes

Bob Gray memorial: The Forest Ridge Association has received \$330.00 in donations from residents of the ridge. Chuck has received one quote and is working on two more.

Volunteer Picnic: Jennifer Kelley mentioned that the picnic was a success. They had roughly 35 people attend.

Halloween Decorations: Tabled this due to no new information.

New Business:

Semi-Annual meeting is scheduled for September 14, 2015 at 7:30pm at the Forest Ridge Baptist Church. There will be a few guest speakers, Jeremy Carnes from the Dayton Fire Department and Juliana Bridgman from Hospice of Miami Valley.

Sue Hanley mentioned updating the guidelines to the Et cetera column due to inquiries regarding paying ads vs. nonpaying ads. Jennifer Kelley and Sue Hanley will work together on updating.


Adjournment: Chuck moved the meeting be adjourned and Sue Hanley seconded.




