# TRASH COLLECTION

Effective January 1, 2016, Republic Services will be your new trash and recycling provider. Your collection day will remain the same as when the City of Dayton collected. Service will start on January 2 for those customers that have Friday collection. Service for the first year will be \$12.64 per month. Your first invoice will be mailed out the week of December 14, 2015 for the first quarter of 2016. Thereafter, property owners will receive quarterly invoices. The invoicing process will be new for 2016 as Riverside customers were previously billed via a property tax assessment. To prevent a discontinuation of service, please pay close attention to your invoices from Republic Services.

As it was with Dayton Waste Collection, Republic will continue to provide the following service:

- ▶ Weekly curbside trash collection: you may use your own trash container or cart (not to exceed 75 pounds).
- ▶ Cart Rental: Republic Services will rental a 35, 65 or 95 gallon trash cart for a fee of \$2.00 per month.
- ▶ Weekly Recycling collection: Republic Services will provide a 35, 65 or 95 gallon recycling cart for free.
- ▶ Bulk waste collection: call 1-800-543-1339 to schedule.
- ▶ Weekly yard waste collection: Include in bags or containers with normal trash.

#### SIGN UP FOR RECYCLING SERVICES BY DECEMBER 18.

Waste collection will occur automatically starting January 2, but for recycling collection and a recycling container, property owners need to contact Republic Services at riverside@republicservices.com or call customer service at 1-800-543-1339. In your email or phone call, provide:

- ▶ Customer name, address, city, state, zip code and phone.
- If you will participate in recycling program and what size cart you'd like (35, 65 or 95 gallon).
- If you would like to rent a trash cart, what size you'd like (35, 65, or 95 gallon).

#### **HOLIDAY SCHEDULE**

Waste and recycling services will not occur on the holiday and all collection will be delayed by one day throughout the remainder of the week. This schedule applies for all residential services. Republic Services observes the following holidays:

- ▶ Memorial Day
- ▶ Thanksgiving Day
- ▶ Independence Day ▶ Christmas Day

#### **COLLECTION OF CITY OF DAYTON CONTAINERS**

You will receive new container(s) from Republic Services. Starting December 26, the City of Dayton will retrieve their waste and recycling containers as part of normal collection. Those containers that are not retrieved in the first pass will be retrieved in January. Republic Services will deliver new carts shortly following the City of Dayton's retrieval of their containers.

# **HOW TO USE YOUR CART**

- ▶ Take every opportunity to fill it with properly prepared recyclable materials.
- Wash it once in a while with dish detergent and water.

### WHAT TO RECYCLE

- Newspaper, corrugated cardboard, glass, aluminum/tin cans and plastics #1 through #7.
- ▶ Rinse all food and beverage containers to avoid attracting animals and insects.
- ▶ Remove any lids and rings on cans or bottles.
- ▶ Check for the recycling arrows on the bottom of all plastic containers. It must have a 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6 or 7 inside.

AND REMEMBER TO PUT IT IN THE CART!



# CARTS MUST BE PLACED AT THE CURB NO LATER THAN 6:00AM ON THE DAY OF COLLECTION.

### **ACCEPTABLE TRASH ITEMS**

Items need to be cut and bundled in 4-foot sections under 75 lbs. each.

**Paint containers** must be empty or solidified prior to being picked up. Use kitty litter or sand to solidify leftover paint.

**Glass, bottles and jars** are acceptable but window panes, storm doors, etc. must be broken up and placed in a taped box marked "glass."

**Appliances and air conditioners** may be placed at the curb once refrigerants have been removed and the unit is ready to be collected.

## **UNACCEPTABLE TRASH ITEMS**

Under federal law, Republic Services is **NOT** permitted to accept tires, batteries, liquids (thinners, oils, acids), combustible materials, medical waste (oxygen, tanks, needles) or any items identified as hazardous.
