Forest Ridge Association Board of Trustees Regular Meeting April 16, 2018

Trustees Present: Larry Ford, Chris Hoopes, Shelton Monger, Charles Mahan, Rich Spielman, Heather Gwin, Emma Hoopes, Youssef Elzein and Cory Hendrix

Trustees Absent:

Larry Ford called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

Minutes: Charles Mahan moved to accept the March minutes. Cory Hendrix seconded.

Vote 9-0-0

Treasurer: Chris Hoopes presented the Treasurer's report for March. The balance of the general fund is \$180,141.49. The balance of the replacement reserve is \$51,840.10. There were 31 full and 4 partial assessments received in March (\$7,523.00) and 6 full and no partial so far in April (\$1,386.00). There are 180 full and 4 partial assessments still open (\$41,900.50). Larry Ford made a motion to accept the report and Chris Hoopes seconded.

Vote 9-0

Shelton Monger voiced a concern in the number of outstanding assessments compared to last year. He suggested that the pool opening will help.

Police Report: No police were present.

Code Enforcement: Mr. Jeremy Leist from Riverside Code Enforcement was present to discuss resident concerns pertaining to unsightly yards.

The board discussed the use of a pool management company and said that they would look towards next season. Skip Mahan recused himself from the discussion for professional reasons.

Karleigh Kessler is the swim team coach for 10 and under while Joseph North is the coach for 11 and up. The open house will be around May 20 and the first day of practice will be the first day the pool is open.

Soccer: Jesse Morgan said that WPAFB is sending 3 teams and we have 3 teams for the 5-6 age group. It has been a rough start due to weather.

New Business: None.

Annual Community Garage Sale!



PROPOSED SWIM LESSONS PROGRAM AND SCHEDULE

Program Coordinator: Pool Manager or his assignee

Classes will cost \$40.00 for Forest Ridge residents and \$35.00 for each child thereafter. \$45.00 for non-Forest Ridge residents and \$40.00 for each additional child. There must be a minimum of 6 students per class instructor and a maximum of 8 students per class.

REGISTRATION FOR EACH SESSION CAN BE MADE AT THE POOL OFFICE for each two week session.

CANCELLATION OF CLASSES: Classes may be cancelled when less than 6 people sign up for the class. All classes may be cancelled due to inclement weather. In such cases every effort will be made to contact the parents before class time.

REFUNDS: Refunds will not be given after the second day of class. If a refund is to be made, a refund card must be completed and signed by the Pool Manager. The card will forwarded to the FRA and a check mailed to you. Missed classes are not made up.

Swim lessons are two weeks in duration. If lessons need to be cancelled the swimmer will be notified of any make up classes.

RULES DURING SWIM LESSONS

- 1. The wading pool will be closed during swimming lessons.
- Only one person per child is allowed to accompany the child in the water during lessons. All other people must remain in the patio area.

3. The pool is open in the morning for swim lessons only.

PRIVATE LESSONS:

- 1. THE LESSONS SHOULD BE ARRANGED THROUGH THE SWIM PROGRAM COORDINATOR.
- 2. A time and instructor will be assigned when you register.
- 3. Private lessons must be cancelled by calling the instructor or Pool
 - Manager at least 24 hours in advance or a full class fee will be charged.

CLASSES OFFERED AND DESCRIPTIONS:

Beginner, Intermediate, Advanced

Other classes may be offered upon sufficient demand and at the discretion of Program Coordinator.

Instructors, at their discretion, may move children into other classes if they feel the child is in the wrong class..



- Everyone must have a pass or be an authorized guest
- * Admission may be refused based on health concerns observed by staff (illness, etc.)
- * All swimmers under age 7 must be accompanied by a guardian or the guardian's designee who is age 13+. To make a designee, the guardian must accompany the swimmer on the first trip to the pool and supply written permission and an emergency contact number.
- * Children ages 8-12 may come swimming alone with written guardian permission. Guardian must accompany swimmer on first trip to the pool to supply written permission and an emergency contact number.
- * During adult swim hours, only persons ages 18+ will be admitted. No children of any age will be admitted.

Pool Grounds Rules

- * No glass containers
- No pets
- * No food in the pool
- * Please place trash in proper receptacles
- No alcoholic beverages
- * Smoking in designated areas only
- * Destruction of pool property will not be tolerated
- No loitering. Anyone causing a disturbance will be asked to leave.
- No profanity
- Bikes must be parked in the bike rack area ONLY
- * FRA is not responsible for loss, theft or damaged property. Please lock up your bikes!
- * No running, pushing, wrestling or rough-housing
- * No fighting—will result in immediate suspension
- * Staff may stop any unsafe action taking place

- * Please wear proper swim attire
- * During periods of peak activity, staff may limit the number of swimmers in the pool.
- Flotation devices allowed at staff discretion
- * All swimmers may be required to pass a basic swim test at the discretion of staff in order to determine if swimmer is safe in water over his or her head.
- A rest period may be required if fatigue or chill is observed
- * Adult swim (18+) will occur 15 minutes before the hour and will last for 15 minutes, excluding the last hour of operations. An adult may bring one child age 6 or under into the L-shaped pool during this time.
- DIVING BOARD: may be closed at staff discretion. Front dives only. No horseplay or swimming in the diving area.
- * WADING POOL: ages 6 and under only. MUST be accompanied by guardian or person ages 13+ AT ALL TIMES. Lifeguard duties do not extend to wading pool.
- * LAP POOL: 2 lanes will be open for laps at all times. During peak times, pool may be opened for general use. After 4pm, adults swimming laps receive preference in use.

Discipline Procedures

- * 1st offense: warning
- 2nd offense: sit out for 20 minutes
- * 3rd offense: Introduction of suspension policy
- First suspension: 3 days
- Second suspension: 5 days
- * Third suspension: 7 days
- * Fourth suspension: review by pool committee for possible seasonal expulsion

In case of serious infarctions, pool staff may escalate discipline procedure as needed. Upon suspensions, parent signature will be required for reentry after penalty period has passed.

Pool rules are for the protection and benefit of all members and guests and have been adopted to secure safe operation in accordance with Ohio Sanitary Code. ALL RULES WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED. The Board of Trustees has empowered the Pool Committee, Pool Manager or staff member in charge with the authority to suspend or expel anyone who does not comply with rules or instructions of onsite staff. The pool may be closed for maintenance, weather, sanitary reasons, or other emergencies as needed with or without advance warning. The pool may also be closed to general use for FRA sanctioned events, such as home swim meets: these will be posted in advance. Any requests for exceptions to pool policies must be addressed in writing to the Board of Trustees.

System In Private Parties Private Parties

- Register at the pool or call pool manager, registration closes 1 day prior to session start
- * Beginner, Intermediate and Advanced classes
- * 2 sessions: June 18 June 29 & July 9 July 20
- Sessions are 2 weeks in duration with lessons
 Monday through Friday in the morning
- * \$40 per session for residents, \$45 for non residents
- No refunds after second day of class
- * Minimum of 6, maximum of 8 students per class
- * Manager may cancel classes without 6 participants
- Instructors may move students into a more suitable class at their discretion
- * Private lessons available, contact manager
- * The pool will ONLY be open for lessons in the morning. No other swimmers will be allowed.
- Only 1 support person on pool deck per student

Guest Passes

- 10 free daily guest passes available per season
- * Daily guest fee \$3, \$1 for ages 6 and under
- 1 non-swimming adult guest in street clothes is free
- Pool manager may limit the number of guests admitted per member at one time
- * Weekly (\$10), monthly (\$25), and seasonal guest passes (see manager) are available to house guests or baby sitters ONLY and are limited to 4 per lot.

- * Scheduled by written request to the manager
- * Start after 8pm and must end by midnight
- 2 hour minimum duration
- \$65 deposit to reserve date, balance due by start of party
- Cancellations must be received 3 days in advance for a full refund.
- FRA initiated cancellations will receive full re-funds.
- * Normal pool rules apply during parties.
- * Fees will be on an hourly rate as follows:

<25 people — \$65/ hour


26-50 people — \$75 / hour

51-100 people — \$85 / hour
