Kids who struggle daily with these conditions should still get to participate in the magic of trick-or-treating without it risking their lives or well-being. Homes that wish to participate indicate their non-candy options by putting out a teal pumpkin. Options include pencils, erasers, stickers, or small toys. Some homes put out an actual pumpkin, while others put a sign on the lawn, and we're still deciding what to do this year

I know it's way too early, but since the stores have decided it's Halloween season and I'm short my main help this season I would like to start a bit early.




