

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# **Pool is Closed for the Season**

Fellow Forest Ridge Association Members,

It is with deep regret that the Board of Trustees is forced to announce that the FRA pool complex will remain closed for the 2020 swim season due to COVID-19. While the Board and Swimsafe worked tirelessly to find a way to meet the Governor's Responsible Restart Ohio plan, the Board has determined that we cannot effectively meet all the health, safety and enforcement requirements needed to mitigate the risks to all our Members. Failure to meet and maintain those standards would therefore pose an unacceptable liability risk to the HOA and would be counter to the fiduciary responsibility of the Board to the Members.

In the meantime, I can assure you the Pool Committee is not going to rest even though we are shut down for the season. For starters, we must continue to maintain the pools so that they don't become a health hazard to the surrounding neighbors. We also intend to work as many capital infrastructure repair and replacement projects that we can fiscally afford in order to improve the function and safety of the pool complex. We also intend to undertake some beautification projects, with the help of volunteers, to try to improve and update the look of the pool house and surrounding area. There is much work that can be done so we intend to make the most of this unfortunate situation.

These have been extraordinary times none of us have experienced and are still trying to navigate. While we're all looking to return to some form of normalcy, we must try to stay as safe and healthy as possible in the process. We look forward to seeing you all at the pool next year!

Maintenance & Greens: Weeds should be sprayed by Leisure Lawn the week of 22 April 2020. Arbor Experts did work today to remove trees. Removed several trees from Little Jeep Park, dead evergreen tree by entrance sign at Silver Oak & Union Schoolhouse Road and Walnut tree by the pool.

Have been in contact with an HR company regarding the employees of FRA. Making sure we have all paper work in order and other HR items.

The lights at the shed have been repaired by DP&L. The line leading into the building needed repaired.

Still working on the issue with water at the shed.

Pool:

Pre-Season repairs required:

L Shape Pool lights sealed (\$185) and replaced broken 4" valve return line (\$403)

Additional plumbing work required in both bathrooms, received an estimate from Deaton Plumbing for \$2.190. Will be getting 2 additional estimates to ensure price is competitive.

L Shape pool water loss monitoring in progress

All Ohio swimming pools are closed until at least 1 May 2020 due to Covid-19

Awaiting decision from State of Ohio on Memorial Day pool opening

Need to develop a plan for pool infrastructure work if closed for season

Working with Swimsafe to develop pool party tracking website Pool passes for Greens and swim Team coaches will be issues as they have in the past.

Spring Soccer has been cancelled

Swim Team: Highly dependent on State of Ohio opening pools. Optimum start is normal 1 June start but July start with foregoing championships is possible.

Mike Bradley will contact Cindy at Towne to let her know that we will be starting the Audit process and to work with Steve and Rich. Mike Bradley asked Mike McHugh to get with Heather Gwin to see if she had any copies of past audits.

Need to have a review of HOA insurance coverage as recommended by Kaman and Cusimano (K&C). Contacted Cincinnati Insurance Company (CIC) for current policies. This has been sent to K&C recommendations with CIC for coverage

options and pricing. Will continue to update Board as an action item


