I wanted to address the issue regarding the Dues coupons from Towne Properties that were sent out. Per the Forest Ridge Collection Policy the due date for HOA Dues is February 28th. If Dues are not received by March 30th then a \$25 late fee will be assessed on the property. The coupon has 2 mistakes in that the due date shows February 1st, with a 2 month window before late fees are assessed, and 1 day early for Dues Late Fees.

I will be addressing this with Towne Properties as this is the second year we have had issues with how their coupons have gone out.

Again, the actual due date is February 28th, with late fees associated with any Dues not received by March 30th.

I lived on Beach Haven Ct. off Cozycroft until I was 12, and then my family moved to Corkwood Dr. and I was so excited because we got to live on the street that had the sidewalk connection to the Forest Ridge pool! My grandmother still lives on Sweetbirch Dr. and I take my daughter trick-or-treating through the neighborhood every year.

Now as an adult, I still really cherish the neighborhood and even though I do not reside here, I want to work to do something good within the Forest Ridge community. Icurrently work as a Volunteer Coordinator for AmeriCorps Seniors, the sister program to AmeriCorps. Forest Ridge has always housed military families from Wright-Patterson Air Force Base and one of our organization's goals is to find ways to serve retired military and veterans through volunteer work. One of the ways we fill this need is through our Senior Companion program which provides companionship to seniors through volunteering with the RSVP program of Montgomery and Greene Counties.

If you are performing any updates or addition to your residence (fences, decks, additions, driveway, sidewalks, car ports, swimming pools) please remember to apply for a permit.

A permit is also needed to have a garage sale. Please remember one garage sale is allowed per quarter and signs are prohibited from being placed in the public right of way. Garage sale permits are FREE.

CITY OF DAYTON ABOUT BUILDING PERMITS

Permits are licenses that grantlegal permission to start construction. Building permits are the means the City of Dayton uses to reduce potential hazards and unsafe construction practices thereby ensuring the public health, safety and welfare.

Once downloaded, an application form can be filled out on your computer, provided you have Adobe Acrobat software. If you have difficulty filling out the form or find problems with a form, please call 937-333-3986.

PERMITS, FORMS & APPLICATIONS

Building/Zoning Application: Apply for one of the following permit types: building, zoning, fire alarm or suppression.

Mechanical Application: Conduct electrical, heating, gas, plumbing, sewer or water work.

Sign Permit Application: Erect or install a sign on your property.

Tent Permit Application: Erect a tent on your project.

Wrecking Permit Application: Use this application to pursue a demolition project.

Zoning Verification Request: Complete application for information, research and documentation.
