Steve Kreckman called the meeting to order at 7: 17 PM Police Report: Dayton Police Present. Not much to report in neighborhood. There was one domestic threat call, and one online fraud case. There have been several car break ins at Cloud Park, so please be aware and keep your cars locked.

Two of the foreclosures pursued by the Board were settled, and past dues all paid.

Maintenance & Greens: Jake Bontatibus reported. Trash dumpster will be paused 4 November through 21 April and it will be locked and monitored by a trail camera to discourage illegal dumping.

Infrastructure: Larry Ford reported. Larry is still waiting on the reserve study to be finished. There was a late

request from the company for some financials that were held up in our transfer from Towne to Associa. We are hoping to have the final report soon.

Pool: Jesse Morgan sent in report, Scott Kreckman reported. He is still negotiating with Swim Safe in order to get contract numbers for next year. Scott was able to clear up some issues with ADT at the pool and the sheds, and is currently working on how to clear up issues with phone lines at the pool.
