#### Forest Ridge Association Board of Trustees Regular Meeting September 26, 2022

**Trustees Present**: Tabitha Bentz, Scott Kreckman, Jesse Morgan, Roberta Havholm, Frank Semmelmayer, Jake Bontatibus, Faith Richardson arrival at 7:11

Trustees Absent: Youssef Elzein

Steve Kreckman called the meeting to order at 7:01 PM

Police Report: None Present

Activities' Participation: We are in desperate need of greater participation in activities. Help has been severely lacking. It is becoming more difficult to make events happen due to a lack of volunteers. The Activities Committee would hate to have to start cancelling events, but this may become necessary if there isn't greater involvement.

**Minutes:** August 2022 meeting minutes reviewed via email. Scott moved to approve as written, Jesse seconded.

**Old Business:** Tree Removal in easements: Scott reached out to the City of Riverside about tree removal, and they will not remove any of theirs in the easement area. Scott is still awaiting a call from the City of Dayton on whether or not they will remove the ones at Jeep Park that are causing greater issues. Smoking at the pool: After reviewing current

State of Ohio laws on smoking and discussing resident concerns about smoking at the pool the Board voted on policy at the pool next year.

Smoking will be prohibited at the pool next year and the smoking area will be permanently removed. Pool Access rules for next year will be discussed at the October meeting.

New Business: Budget set up and review will be next month. Those committee heads with budget needs will be preparing their needs over the next month. Jake proposed pulling the Community Garden under a Board Committee and potentially provide it a budget. Larry brought up our need to add a snow removal line to our budget for Greens Area.

**Resident Comments:** Gander Road Association enters all meeting attendees into a raffle to pay their dues for a year; maybe the Board should consider this moving forward to up meeting attendance.

**Adjournment**: Scott moved to adjourn the meeting, Frank seconded
