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Forest Ridge Association Members,

It is that time of year again and Dues Payment Slips have been mailed out to your homes for 2024. I wanted to take the time to state the dues rates again as we posted them in previous Murmurs after they were locked in for the year. *This years dues are \$406.18 and will be due February 28th. However, no late fees will be assessed until after March 30th.*

Associa does not mail-date payments, so if you are mailing a check please be sure to mail it well in advance so that it arrives BEFORE that March 30th date. Late fees will be assessed after that and there is ample time given for these dues to be paid.

If you fail to pay your dues on time the late fees assessed will continue to be billed to the account quarterly. Usually toward the end of the year a letter is mailed from the lawyers to warn you that you are behind on your dues and you need to pay them or a lien can be placed on the property. Please do not let it get to this point. Liens will be placed by the end of the year if dues are no paid promptly. All legal fees and late payments will be part of the new total.

You can pay via check using the payment slips sent by Associa, or you can get on their App called Town Square. You will need the access code to get into the App if you go that route. You can contact Associa for this code at 888-612-2299.

Again, the **dues for 2024 are \$406.18**, they're due by February 28th, and late fees will begin to be assessed after March 30th. Don't wait to send your dues if mailing to ensure they get there before that cutoff date!
