#### Forest Ridge Association Board of Trustees Regular Meeting February 19, 2024

Trustees Present: Scott Kreckman, Tabitha Bentz, Faith Richardson, Roberta Havholm, Jake Bontatibus, Jesse Morgan (arrived at 7:05 PM)

Trustees Absent: Larry Ford, Frank Semmelmayer Scott Kreckman called the meeting to order at 7: 02 PM Police Report: Dayton Police in Attendance. Only report, was 4 vehicle thefts in the general area (2 at Cloud Park Apartments, 2 in other surrounding areas). Everything else has been quiet in the area and the neighborhood.

Foreclosure Update: Two Foreclosures have been completed. We are still awaiting the distribution of these funds.

Minutes: Scott moved to approve the Minutes as written, Roberta seconded

Vote: 5-0

HOA Positions: There is still one open Board position if anyone is interested.

Treasurer: Faith reported.

Operating Funds Financial Report– January 2024

Communications: Roberta reported. There was not much for the February Murmurs so it went online. March edition will go to print, and will include soccer information. Deadline is March  $1^{\rm st}$ .

Maintenance & Greens: Jake reported. Over the winter, we didn't really face any issues with snow removal as we didn't receive much snow. Pool rental rules will be updated with Jesse before the season begins. Pool house office flooring will be updated/replaced, decks will be power-washed. We do have a new Greens Company this year. We anticipate a better situation moving forward as we have a better working relationship with the new company, and we will be able to address issues more quickly. RESIDENT QUESTION: Will we be removing the one shed that is in bad shape?

SCOTT ANSWERED: This is a part of our Infrastructure plan. Currently, we don't have the funds to replace it and as we sort through the remaining items, we believe we can get down to one shed and will eliminate that damaged one when that becomes a need/possibility

Infrastructure: Scott reported. Our current numbers from the reserve study have proven to below estimates for some items-including the replacement of the large entry sign to the neighborhood. We will be looking at the Culverts near Jeep Park, Pool Restrooms, Maintenance Shed, and some sidewalk work this year.

Pool: Jesse reported. Not much to report at this time. Jesse has been having a few pre-season conversations with Swim Safe. Currently all estimated for needed work is typical and anticipated maintenance work. They have helped with some

research on new flooring options, currently stamped concrete may be the best avenue.

Additionally, we are clearing the whole pool registry and everyone will have to get new pool passes with photos for this year. The intent is to have several weekend hours the weeks before the pool opens in order to help get people new passes. Audit: Scott Reported. Registration with the State expires in August and Associa is working on the renewal paperwork. Elections: Scott reported. We still have an open board seat if anyone would like to join.

Old Business: Scott reported. Jane Magnolia Trees sponsored be residents will be planted along the Boulevard in the Spring. There were several interested residents who have paid for trees and plaques. Scott will be ordering the plaques in the next 2 weeks, and the trees will be ordered once we are comfortably past our last freeze.

New Business. Scott reported. Rita Harper is our new representative from Associa and are hoping to have a representative present at Memorial Day event.

Quote received for the Pool roof from Gebhart Construction. \$13, 185 for tear off, install of drip edge, and felt, pipe flashings, 2 new power vents and shingles, and \$4,300 estimated if plywood underneath is shot and needs replaced. There will be a 6% increase on shingles associated with the estimate on April 1st. Jake and Scott will look into a few more estimates, before the Board votes. A resident also suggested reaching out to those in the neighborhood who may have those skills that could help. Jake and Scott were going to look into that as an option and seek a few more quotes before the Board votes on which quote to accept. Resident Comments: A resident asked about any HOA regulation on an addition to the house. Scott answered that our only regulation with dwellings is no 3 car garages and no secondary dwellings.
