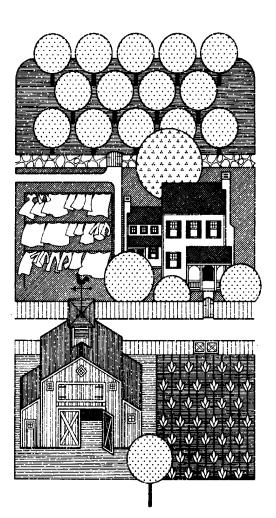

Vandalism at Jeep Park was a major hit, and Scott has contacted the original company to attempt to purchase a replacement slide. Scott is still speaking with the City of Riverside to get a waiver to have a lit sign at the main entrance.

Pool: Jesse reported. The leak in the kiddie pool has been identified and concrete work will be done in the Spring, but we are still awaiting a quote. We had one late payment to ADT over the summer, but it is being addressed by Associa now.

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2025 ASSESSMENT NEWS

On November 18, 2024, the Forest Ridge Board voted on and approved the 2025 budget for the Forest Ridge Homeowners Association. The first thing we had to do was establish what, if any increase in dues there would be for 2025. After some deliberations, despite CPI being 2.4% we did not increase the full amount for 2025. Instead, it was only raised enough to cover some of the increased costs we are seeing for contracts, and to make it an even number. **The 2025 Dues will be an even \$415**, and as always, will be due February 28th, 2025. These are your important dates for Dues in 2025:

February 28, 2025: \$415 (not including fees for credit cards) Dues are due into Associa by this date.

Postmarks are not tracked, so you MUST plan and get these payments in before this date.

March 30, 2025: Late fees begin to be assessed if the payment is not RECEIVED before this date.
