# Forest Ridge Association Board of Trustees Regular Meeting February 17, 2025

Trustees Present: Scott Kreckman, Tabitha Bentz, Frank Semmelmayer, Roberta Havholm, Jesse Morgan, Faith Richardson, Jake Bontatibus (arrived 7:10)

Trustees Absent: Jake Bontatibus

Scott Kreckman called the meeting to order at 7: 00 PM Announcements: Scott Kreckman will be resigning from the Presidency and the Board as of the September meeting. He will remain on the Activities Committee.

Police Report: Dayton Police in attendance. Not much to report. One stolen car in the neighborhood that was quickly recovered, a small incident at the Jimmy Johns, and a broken car window at Tom Cloud Park. Scott made the police aware of vandalism at Little Jeep Park, but they did provide a few suggestions and asked for us to call in official reports as they can help them build a bigger picture.

Minutes: Frank moved to approve with Jesse's amendment, Roberta seconded.

Vote: 7-0

HOA Positions: There is still one open Board position if anyone is interested.

Treasurer: Faith reported.

Communications: Roberta reported. Murmurs will begin going out next week as soon as Roberta receives her copy of the dues letter to include.

Maintenance & Greens: Jake reported. Things are slower over the winter, but with Scott's help, an advertisement went out for a new contractor. Starting to seek out paint estimates for the covered deck area of the pool. The slats on the small bridge from the parking lot to the pool area will need to be addressed once warmer weather arrives. Vehicles in green spaces is continuing to be a major issue, causing significant damage. Jake is looking for any potential solutions to this issue. Jake would also like input on what HOA responsible sidewalks are in most need of being replaced.

Infrastructure: Scott reported. He will be submitting a waiver for the Silver Oak signage lighting to the City of Riverside this week. Our current estimate is only for replacement and will include demo once the weather warms enough for an estimate.

Pool: Jesse reported. We are still awaiting a firm estimate on the pipe leak replacement at the pool-currently between \$3000-\$5000 depending on amount of concrete. Jesse is working on the code for the new pool cards for the upcoming season. His plan is to have it fully available by Memorial Day.

Activities: Victoria reported.

Audit: Scott Reported. Audit should be completed soon.

Old Business: Scott reported. Tennis court painting is the only thing left at the Tennis Courts, and weather should be warm enough by April. The new flooring for the pool is due to ship in the next few weeks and will need volunteers to help move items and lay floor once it arrives and weather improves. No movement on small claims court currently. We still have not been able to locate a replacement slide for the Jeep Park playground, but are continuing to search.

New Business: A resident requested that moving forward we include the number of attendees and households at each meeting.

Frank moved to adopt this policy, Faith seconded.

Vote: 8-0

February Meeting Attendance: 3 residents, representing 2 Households

A resident also asked if we could do a push notification through our app for future Murmurs. Roberta will investigate how to do that.

Another resident expressed gratitude for all the Board does, especially Scott and Tori, to make it such a great neighborhood and an awesome place to raise a family.
